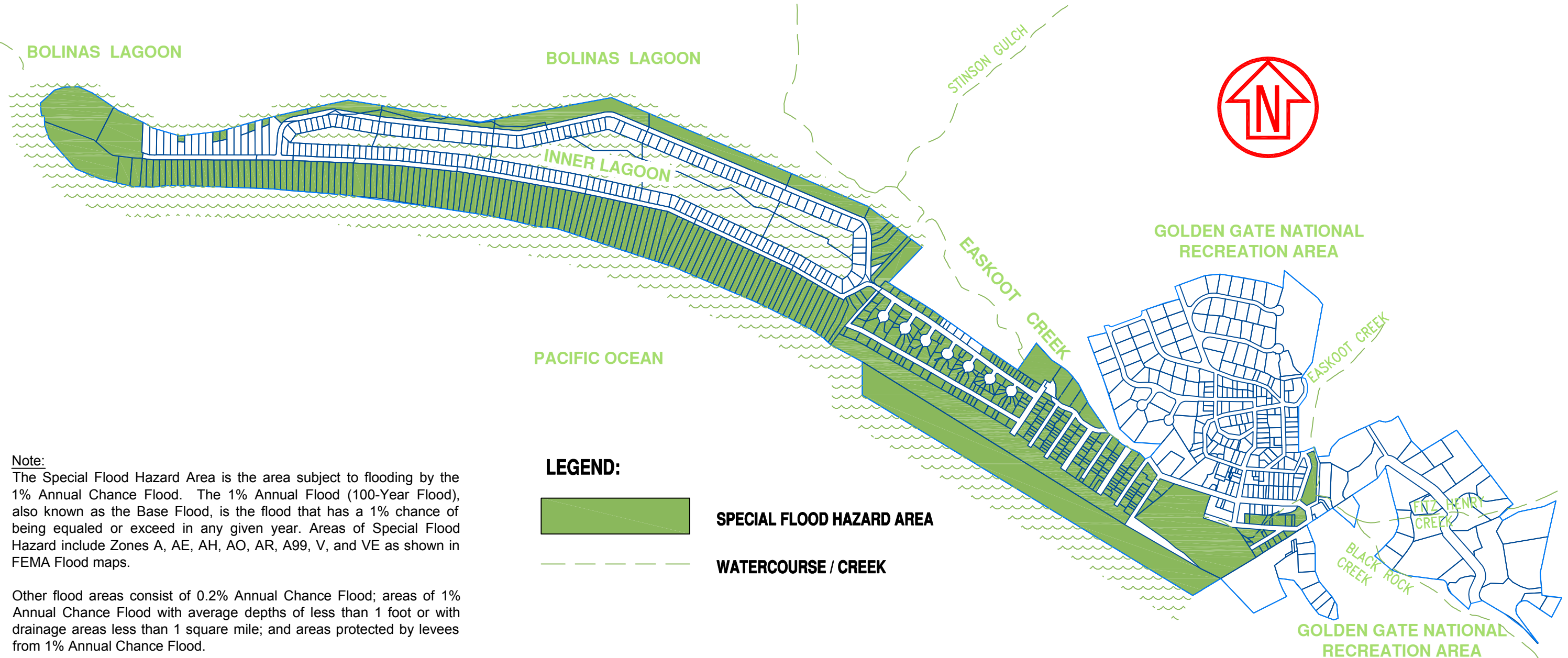


SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREA SUBJECT TO INUNDATION BY THE 1% ANNUAL CHANCE FLOOD



Note:
 The Special Flood Hazard Area is the area subject to flooding by the 1% Annual Chance Flood. The 1% Annual Flood (100-Year Flood), also known as the Base Flood, is the flood that has a 1% chance of being equaled or exceeded in any given year. Areas of Special Flood Hazard include Zones A, AE, AH, AO, AR, A99, V, and VE as shown in FEMA Flood maps.

Other flood areas consist of 0.2% Annual Chance Flood; areas of 1% Annual Chance Flood with average depths of less than 1 foot or with drainage areas less than 1 square mile; and areas protected by levees from 1% Annual Chance Flood.

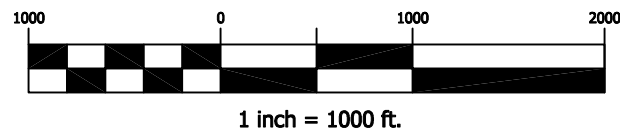
This map provides an interpretative representation of the Special Flood Hazard area as shown on the FEMA Flood maps for the Stinson Beach community.
